



IMPORTANCE OF NCC

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the Indian military cadet corps with its Head Quarters at New Delhi. NCC is open to all of the students of school and college on the voluntary basis. NCC was conceived in 1917 when India Defence Act was promulgated with an objective of making up the deficiencies in the Armed Forces by raising the University Corps. In 1920 the India Territorial Act was passed and University Corps was replaced by University Training Corps.

Aims of N.C.C and its advantages:

The **National Cadet Corps** has the basic aim of developing character, "**commander ship, discipline, the spirit of adventure, a secular outlook,**" and "**ideals of selfless**" services amongst young citizens.

NCC is one of the bodies of India that are **highly reputable** and through which candidates can learn **leadership, honesty, discipline, confidence,** hard work like skills.

It is the second most defense line of the country from which candidates can join **Army, Navy and Air force** of the country.
