

NK Jadunath Singh, PVC was born on 21 Nov 1916 in Khajuri Village Shahjahanpur, Uttar Pradesh. He studied up to fourth standard only and was the wrestling champion of his village. He joined British Indian Army 7th Rajput Regiment in 1941 and served in second world war fighting in Burma. After partition in 1947 NK Jadunath Singh was serving in 1st Rajput Regiment. On 06th Feb 1948 when his Regiment was deployed at Tain Dhar, of Naushera J&K, his picket received heavy fire from Pakistani forces. NK Jadunath was section Commander of that forward post consisting nine soldiers. His section repulsed Pakistani attack thrice & by the end of the third wave though all his men were casualties NK Jadunath Singh single handedly charged on enemy & met his gallant death when two bullets hit him in the head and chest. NK Jadunath Singh was posthumously awarded PVC. The bust of, NK Jadunath Singh was installed at Kachari Road, Shahjahanpur (UP). 25 UP BN NCC, Shahjahanpur (UP) has adopted the Statue for upkeep & maintenance.
