The First Awareness class is Conducted by Aluva Fire and Rescue Team Members. They Explained what fire is and what types it is, and Conducted an awareness Session on Fire related hazards and how to deal with them.

In this regard, what should be done and not done in case of a gas cylinder leak, what should be taken care of, and how to solve it without fear was shown and the students were made to do it by showing a demo live.

The Next Awareness Session was Conducted by Aluva CMO. Dr. Jyotsana and Medical team Members of District Hospital Aluva. They Carried the Session on the topic First Aid and Basic Life Support Skills. They told us about Many Misconceptions in the Medical field that we have been believing for ages and made us understand what is right and also Explained what first aid is and how to save a person's life from sudden Emergencies. It was also an Interactive Session with students, so all of them raised many doubts and cleared doubts accordingly.

The last Session was held at afternoon by Saji Vallasser. Sir. on the topic Survival Swimming Awareness, Firstly He talked about the benefits of Swimming through seeing Many V. 2nd Inspired us to learn Swimming through Many Videos. He + it seeks out and Motivates People with Various disabilities to learn Swimming and teaches them to Swim. More than half of Drowning deaths are in Kerala, Aluva Swimming club is an Initiative started with the aim of preventing any More Drowning deaths. Through the Videos he shown, he got Everyone thinking about why we can't swim even with amputees.

From All these Session they took a hundreds of students to train about the Various disabilities and of Management. Also Geerin Saji, a Senior Non-Commissioned Officer and a Final Year graduate student of Union Christian College Aluva, who represented Kerala in the Republic Day Camp, was facilitated at the functions.
