No. HFW-MEII-ESTT-0026-2021/ 12853/H&F.W., Bhubaneswar, Dated 28-04-2021

Keeping in view of the resurgence of Covid-19 pandemic across the State, after careful consideration, the Government have been pleased to issue instructions for institutions under the domain of H & FW Department as follows :

1. All the professional institutions (Private and Government) under H & FW Department like D- Pharm, B Pharm, M Pharm, DMLT, DMRT, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Allied Medical Science, Master in Public Health(MPH), and all Nursing institutions shall remain closed from 19.4.2021.
2. All classes and examinations shall be conducted by online mode only.
3. All boarders except the Superspecialty, PG (Medical), Interns (Medical), final MBBS, final BSc Nursing, final GNM Nursing shall vacate the hostel.
4. All ongoing offline University examinations which are likely to be completed in the month of April shall be allowed to continue observing the Covid appropriate behavior.
5. The authorities of institutions shall take all appropriate measures for conducting classes on online mode to complete the syllabus.
6. Teaching, non teaching and ministerial employees of the institutions shall work as per prevailing Covid guidelines.

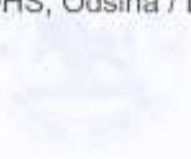
