Sub: COVID related restrictions for mitigation and containment- regarding.

Government Order No. 24-JK (DMRRR) of 2021.

Dated: 25.04.2021

- 1) Whereas, a detailed review of the current COVID situation in Jammu and Kashmir was conducted by the Hon'ble Lt Governor, Jammu and Kashmir, with the Chief Secretary, J&K, Financial Commissioner, Health; Administrative Secretary School Education, Administrative Secretary Higher Education; Divisional Commissioner, Jammu/Kashmir and other officers, particularly on the following:
 - a. An overall assessment of the situation pertaining to the spread of COVID-19 in Jammu and Kashmir, and
 - b. The prevailing trend of rise in the daily reported cases of infection in J&K.
- 2) On the basis of the above assessment, the State Executive Committee, in exercise of the powers conferred up on it under section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, hereby orders the following—
 - a. Night curfew timings within municipal / urban local body limits of all 20 districts of Jammu and Kashmir shall be from 8 pm to 6 am instead of 10 pm to 6 am.
 - b. All Paid public parks in the UT of J&K shall remain closed for visitors till further orders.
