

Short Animation Film Contest on 75 years of Indian Independence

Terms and Conditions

1. This contest is open only for Indian Citizens.
2. All entries for the animated short films must be submitted to the Creative Corner Section of www.MyGov.in. Entries submitted through any other medium / mode will not be entertained nor considered for evaluation.
3. The content of the animated short films should be suitable for Universal viewing.
4. Participant shall make sure that his/her personal profile is accurate and updated since MoI&B / NFDC will be using this for further communication. This includes details, such as name, photo, ID Proof, phone number and email address. Entries with incomplete profiles will not be entertained nor considered.
5. The top entries, which receive a prize for animated short films, will be the intellectual property of the MoI&B and the winner cannot exercise any right over it, after acceptance of the prize.
6. The prize-winning animated short films are meant to be used by the MoI&B / NFDC for promotional and display purposes and also for any other use as may be deemed appropriate for the initiative by MoI&B/NFDC and not for any commercial purpose.
7. The submissions should be of original works and no plagiarism will be entertained/considered for evaluation. The participant shall indemnify MoI&B / NFDC for any issue arising out of plagiarism and the participant concerned shall be personally liable for the same. Anyone found infringing on others copyright would be disqualified from the Contest.
8. The animated short films must not contain any provocative, objectionable or inappropriate content since the animated short films is intended for viewing by all age groups.
9. Any politically inclined or offensive content / violation of community standards, will not be entertained and will be treated as an offense under Cyber Law
10. MoI&B / NFDC reserve the right to cancel or amend all or any part of the Contest and/or the Terms & Conditions/ Evaluation Criteria. However, any changes to the Terms & Conditions/ Evaluation Criteria, or cancellation of the Contest, will be updated/ posted on contest page on the MyGov platform. Participants are responsible to keep themselves informed as to any changes in the Terms & Conditions/Evaluation criteria stated for this Contest.
11. The Participant(s) represent(s) and warrant(s) that he/she will comply with all the applicable Indian laws. The Participant(s) shall not disclose and/or use any information, if doing so is in violation of any obligation against confidentiality.
12. MoI&B / NFDC reserves the right to reject any entry of the participant without assigning any reason.
13. MoI&B / NFDC accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss or injury of any kind suffered by any participants in entering the Contest, including as a result of any participant winning or not winning any prize.

14. Multiple submissions of entries by the same participant will not be considered and the first entry per participant received would be considered.
15. The Contestant shall be responsible for any and all taxes payable on the prize money received.
16. In the event any of the contestants choose not to receive the prize money the prize money shall be forfeited and dealt by MoI&B/NFDC at their discretion
17. All entries in each category will be judged based on creativity, originality and composition by NFDC/MoI&B
18. The winners will be declared through email and by way of announcing their names on the MyGov blog page.
19. The courts of Delhi alone shall have exclusive jurisdiction to deal with and decide any dispute whatsoever arising out of this Contest.
20. Employees of MoI&B and NFDC, and their immediate family members including spouse, children, parents and parents-in-law are not eligible to participate in this contest.
21. Entries shall be evaluated for deciding about the prize(s) by the jury based on the content, film's Quality and appropriateness to the theme. MoI&B reserves its right to rationalize the prize(s), in case the entries do not conform to the Quality and appropriateness to the themes. The decision of MoI&B with regard to this will be final and binding on the contestants.
22. By registering for participation in the Contest, the Participant(s) warrant that:
 - i) They have complied with these terms and conditions;
 - ii) Their name is original;
 - iii) Their entry does not infringe any Intellectual Property Rights of any third party;
 - iv) Any current employer and/or learning institution that the participant is employed by or enrolled with will have no claim on the animated short film developed and submitted.
