

## Artha Chitra - IEPFA Poster Making Competition

### Terms & Conditions

1. The theme of the topics suggested for the poster making competition should be strictly adhered to. The competition will enhance awareness amongst students regarding the concept and need of introducing financial literacy at an early age in a simplified way.
2. All entries should be submitted on an individual basis. No shared work is allowed.
3. A participant may give any number of entries but in their respective category only.
4. Poster should not contain any personal details like Name, Class, College etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in registration form only.
5. Students will have to make a poster with a caption/ tagline on the given theme.
6. The entries will be open during the period 05 May – 25 May 2022. No entries will be accepted after this date.
7. Any mixed media suitable for reproduction as a poster is allowed, including computer-generated graphics. Posters must be two dimensional.
8. All posters must be original art only. No trademarked or copyrighted images or phrases should be used, with the exception of the IEPFA logo, if applicable.
9. Digital designs should be submitted as a 300 dpi JPG or PDF. If submitting a traditional painting or drawing, it should be scanned and sent as a 300 dpi JPG or PDF and clearly visible.
10. The winning poster design may be displayed and reproduced at various platforms of IEPFA, at the sole discretion of the authority. The IEPFA will assume full ownership of the content, including any profits if the poster is ever associated with a sale.
11. Except as used by the IEPFA, all artists, including the winner, will retain the rights to their work. Entry in the contest constitutes full permission to publish names and photos of winners without further compensation. The determination of eligibility of entries and any interpretation of these rules is at the sole discretion of the IEPFA only and shall be final and binding upon all entrants.
