Video-Clip Contest for Societal Heroes

Terms and Conditions

- Participants can only participate in the contest by registering on the MyGov platform.
- Video exceeding the time limit are liable to be rejected. The video should be shot in HD format.
- Clips can be shot on smartphone or a video camera. The film will need to be shot in 1920x1080p (Full HD). However, a lower resolution is permissible for purposes of entering the contest.
- The clips needs to be uploaded on to YouTube as UNLISTED (it should not be available on search engines or available in public domain). The YouTube link needs to be submitted on MyGov.in as the entry. Any film that is in public domain, will be disqualified.
- Captions and credits if any, must be in legible font and color and must be within the safe areas.
- Organizers will have non-exclusive perpetual rights to screen all film entries on any internet-based platform of its choice or in any Vigyan Prasar event, as and when required.
- Video-clip makers must write a short synopsis of clip in English or Hindi in at least 50 words at the time of upload.
- The entry must not contain any provocative, objectionable, or inappropriate content.
- The participant must be the same person who has made the clip. You must be the sole author and owner of the copyright of the content submitted and the same should not have been previously published in any print and digital media.
- Please note that the clip must be original and should not violate any provision of the Indian Copyright Act, 1957. Anyone found infringing on others' copyright would be disqualified from the Competition.
- No entries will be accepted after last date of submission.

Selection criterion:

- ✓ The entries would be judged on the basis of clarity of subject & content and not from the cinematic point of view.
- ✓ Clarity of videos would be appreciated however very high resolution or clear videos that have been made using professional video cameras will enjoy no edge in evaluation.
- ✓ A video clip made using a simple mobile camera qualifies for the entry.
- ✓ The language should be simple and easy to comprehend.
- ✓ Entries only in Hindi and English languages are allowed.
