AND WHEREAS it is essential to enforce social distancing of people to prevent the spread of the disease;

AND WHEREAS, in view of this it is necessary to take exigent measures in this regards so as to prevent any danger to human life or safety, to thwart the spread of virus, which may affect the overall security of the State and may create disturbance of larger public order and tranquility;

AND WHEREAS, in my considered opinion, there is sufficient grounds for proceeding under sub section (1) of Section 144 of Code of Criminal

any business/trade, industrial undertakings or any other establishments, except essential services within North Goa district with effect from 00:00 hrs of 23/3/2020 (i.e. intervening midnight of 22nd and 23rd March, 2020) to 00:00 hrs of 26/3/2020(i.e. intervening midnight of 25th March 2020 and 26th March 2020)

AND WHEREAS, I am satisfied that the circumstances do not permit the serving, in due time, of the notices individually upon the persons against whom this order is directed and therefore, under the powers vested in me under sub section (2) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I hereby pass the order ex-parte.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **R. Menaka, IAS, District Magistrate, North Goa District**, in exercise of the powers vested in me under sub section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, do hereby order for closure of the following in North Goa District except essential services with effect from **00:00 hrs of 23/3/2020 (i.e. intervening midnight of 22nd and 23rd March, 2020) to 00:00 hrs of 26/3/2020(i.e. intervening midnight of 25th March 2020 and 26th March 2020)**

1. All Government Departments
2. State Government Industrial Departments
3. Industries
4. Private Establishments including factories and companies
5. Any Business/ Trade, industrial undertakings or any other establishments

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

Failure to comply with this order shall result in the cancellation of license and the owner or offender shall be liable for penal action under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 30 of the Excise Duty Act, 1964 and other relevant provisions of laws in force.
