- All Indian citizens may participate.
- Incomplete entries will not be considered.
- It can be geo-tagged or non-geo-tagged selfies with the monuments.
- Entries shall be submitted in JPEG and PDF format only.
- The photographs should be shot in HD Standard having pixel appropriate size and image size within the limit of 2MB.
- File should be of high resolution – at least 1000 pixels per inch at 100% size. File should look clean (not pixelated or bit-mapped) when viewed on screen at 100%. Entries should not be submitted in compressed or self-extracting formats.
- All entries obtained through unauthorised sources, or which are incomplete, illegible, mutilated, altered, reproduced, forged, irregular, or fraudulent in any way or otherwise not in compliance with the rules are automatically void.
- It is strongly advised not to wait until the deadline for the submission of entries. Organisers shall not be responsible for non-receipt of entries on account of server errors/ traffic.
- The Organisers reserve the right to change the competition's regulations, date, and time at any moment without providing any justification and without imposing any kind of duty on the participant(s).
- The Organisers may choose or reject any submission.
- The Organisers shall have no liability whatsoever for any inconvenience/loss directly or indirectly caused to any Participant due to such modification of rules/cancellation of competition and the Participants shall accordingly not be entitled to raise any claims pertaining to the same.
- Once the participants have made submissions on the platform, they shall have no claim even in the event of stoppage/cancellation of the competition.
