Sir, Article 21A of the constitution is as follows:

“21A. The State shall provide free and compulsory education to all children of the age of six to fourteen years in such manner as the State may, by law, determine.”

My humble suggestion is to insert the word “scientific” in this article.

“21A. The State shall provide free and compulsory **scientific** education to all children of the age of six to fourteen years in such manner as the State may, by law, determine.”

This change may also support article 51 A:

“51 A, It shall be the duty of every citizen of India .....

(h) **to develop the scientific temper**, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;”
